REMINDERS

The Board has received an increasing number of complaints regarding restriction violations. Here is a reminder regarding the most frequent complaints:

Park cars, trucks, etc. in driveways and not on the streets. Regarding boats, trailers, and RVs, the Board asks that you refer to Sec. 4.4 and 4.9 of the "Restrictions" for details

No sign of any kind, except standard real estate signs, shall be displayed to the public view on or from any building site without the prior consent of the

Council or its agents. Refer to Section 4.5.

Please remember to clean up after your pets as noted in Section 4.11.

Any curtain or window covering backing which faces the street must be white or off-white. See Section 4.12.
