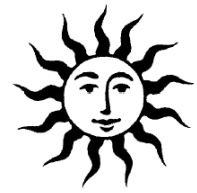

### **Dog Concerns**

In March, an incident occurred in which an unleashed dog ran in an aggressive manner toward a group of neighbors.

East Baton Rouge Parish leash laws state: "Dogs must be confined at all times either in the owner's home or fenced yard or on a leash no longer than 6 feet."

Also: "If your dog becomes a nuisance, you may be fined. Examples of a nuisance would be running at large, attacking other people or animals, chasing cars, making excessive noise, turning over garbage cans or damaging, soiling or defecating on property other than the owner's."

The JT6 restrictions (Section 4.11) specifically state: "No pet shall be allowed to leave its excrement on any other lot or common area."

Thoughtful consideration and awareness by all dog owners will be most appreciated.
