## Safety - for the kids

## Street signs

The JT6 board has shown examples of street signs available to "spruce up" our neighborhood and received positive feedback about this.

This will be done in stages starting with street signs (14 total) and, over the next several years, further traffic signs (30 total). This and our increased security patrol will require a dues increase next year to \$100.
