BURGLARY PREVENTION AND TIPS

Lt. Mike Rhoads from the Sheriff’s Department met with residents at the annual meeting June 29. There have been 5 home burglaries (day) and 5 vehicle burglaries (night) from March-June. Tips for burglary prevention:

- Get to know your neighbors
- Call in suspicious persons or vehicles to the Sheriff (see phone numbers below)
- Turn your alarm system on
- Always lock your car
- Keep a list of serial numbers from your purchases. This can help recovery efforts and convictions
