Seigen Plaza Update

At the recent Board Meeting, Buddy Stockwell presented the following update regarding the commercial shopping center development planned behind Ashbrook.

Several JT6 residents attended the June 24 council meeting and were surprised to learn that our issue was not entitled to a public hearing. Buddy was not allowed to speak on behalf of JT6. How-

ever, he was able to schedule a meeting with the developer at a later date.

In July, Buddy and Tim Martinez met with Milton Womack, Steve Carville, Wayne Sledge and Councilman David Boneno. Thanks to Buddy's efforts, Mr. Womack agreed to build a 6' fence with galvanized poles, as well as landscaping between the fence

and the development. Buddy received confirmation of this agreement in writing.

This victory resulted from a significant investment of time and effort by Buddy and others to maintain the standard of living in JT6. The Board thanks everyone who showed their support regarding this issue.
